STATEMENT OF FAITH

- **We believe** the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God (2 Timothy 3:16-17).
- **We believe** there is one God, eternally existing as Father, Son and Holy Spirit (Exodus 20:2-3, 1 John 5:7, 1 Corinthians 8:6).

- **We believe** in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whom Christ indwells each believer enabling him to live a godly life of obedience as he reaches for maturity.
- **We believe** that the Holy Spirit unites all true believers in the Lord Jesus Christ and that together they form one body, the church.
