

Peer Support Specialist/Outreach Team Member TSOS Job Description

Daily operations for the Temporary Safe Outdoor Space (TSOS) will be conducted by Outreach Team Members with Hope Rescue Mission. OTMs are expected to work closely with TSOS residents to assist in case management coordination and guiding residents through the next steps in their journey (obtaining and ID, identifying housing resources, connecting residents to resources and organizations to meet behavioral, mental and physical health needs, etc.)

The PSS Outreach Team Member is expected to maintain a log of all occupants, any rule violations, any action to mediate conflicts among occupants or to report emergency response. The representative will be required to walk the perimeter of the TSOS hourly to maintain a consistent presence, be available for any questions or concerns among residents, and to ensure that walkways are clear in the event emergency response is needed. Daily temperature checks for occupants will be the responsibility of the OTM and he/she will need to contact the Site Director to coordinate getting medical attention, if needed, for COVID symptoms.
